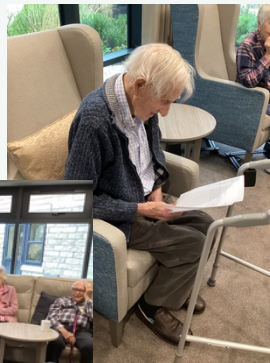
Our amazing Year 5 girls who took part in MySkillz Project finished with a fantastic showcase at The Grand Theatre
