

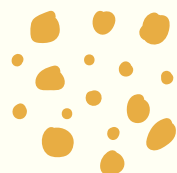

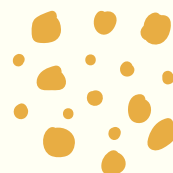

This year, the competition theme is

"Rebuilding"

Share your creative talents and show what this theme means to you!

You may wish to create a piece of artwork about...

- the rebuilding of Barrow URC Primary School
- rebuilding lives after war
- rebuilding relationships when you fall out
- rebuilding your Lego bricks into another creation
- ...or you may have an even better idea!

The important thing is:

- be creative
- use different media to create your artwork (pencils, pastels, paints, collage, textiles)
- show how your artwork relates to the theme 'Rebuilding'
- express your ideas through your selected medium

Your artwork must be no bigger than A2 in size

Age groups:

- Junior: 7 to 10 years old
- Intermediate: 11 to 13 years old

(Entrants must not be over the upper age parameter for each group on 31 August 2023)
