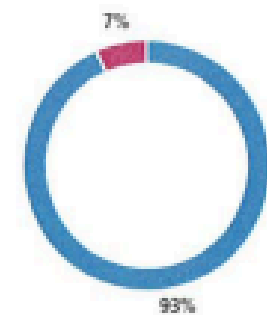

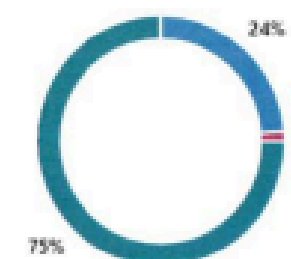

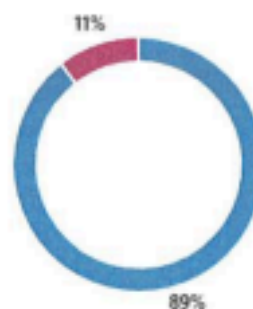

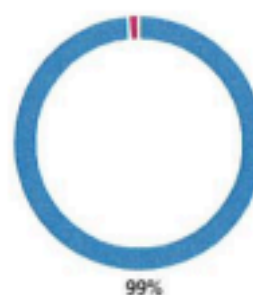
7. Barrow URC Primary School has high expectations for my child

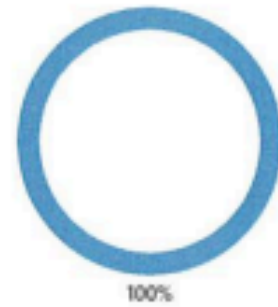
8. My child does well at Barrow URC Primary School

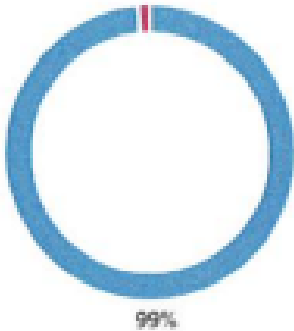

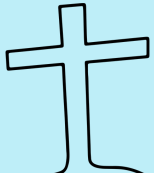
